Act One: Scene One

"Belle"

BELLE

Little town, it's a quiet village Every day like the one before Little town full of little people Waking up to say...

(Villagers enter and begin to bustle about their daily business)

GROUP 1 Bonjour GROUP 2 Bonjour GROUP 3 Bonjour Bonjour BAKER Bonjour

(The Baker carries a tray of rolls)

BELLE

There goes the baker with his tray, like always The same old bread and rolls to sell Every morning just the same Since the morning that we came To this poor provincial town

BAKER

Good morning, Belle! **BELLE** Morning, Monsieur **BAKER** Where you off to? **BELLE** The bookshop. I just finished the most wonderful story about a beanstalk and an ogre and....

(But he's not interested. He yells over his shoulder to his wife.)

BAKER

That's nice. Marie! The baguettes! Hurry up!

(Belle sighs... never mind. She continues on her way. Various townspeople talk about her as she passes)

GROUP 1 & 2 (ALL GIRLS) Look there she goes The girl is strange, no question Dazed and distracted, can't you tell? **GROUP 1** Never part of any crowd **GROUP 3** Cause her head's up on some cloud **GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE)** No denying she's a funny girl, that Belle **GROUP 3** Bonjour **GROUP 1** Good day **GROUP 3** How is your family? **GROUP 2** Bonjour **GROUP 4** Good day **GROUP 2** How is your wife? **GROUP 1** I need... six eggs **GROUP 2** That's too expensive BELLE There must be more than this provincial life!

(Belle walks to the Book Shop. A kindly Bookseller turns around, pleased to see her.)

BOOKSELLER

Ah, Belle! **BELLE** Good morning. I've come to return the book I borrowed **BOOKSELLER** Finished already? **BELLE** Oh, I couldn't put it down. Have you got anything new? **BOOKSELLER**

(He chuckles.)

Not since yesterday
BELLE
That's all right. I'll borrow...this one!
BOOKSELLER
That one? But you've read it twice!
BELLE
Well, it's my favourite. Far-off places, daring sword fights, magic spells, a prince in disguise...
BOOKSELLER
If you like it all that much...it's yours.
BELLE
But sir!
BOOKSELLER
I insist
BELLE
BELLE

Well, thank you. Thank you very much!

(She exits and continues through town.)

GROUP 3 & 4 (ALL BOYS)

Look there she goes that girl is peculiar I wonder if she's feeling well **GROUP 1 & 2 (ALL GIRLS)** With a dreamy far off look **GROUP 3 & 4 (ALL BOYS)** And her nose stuck in a book **GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE)** What a puzzle to the rest of us is Belle

(Belle sits on a fountain, engrossed in her book.)

BELLE

Oh... isn't this amazing? It's my favourite part because... you'll see Here's where she meets Prince Charming But she won't discover that it's him 'Til chapter three

GROUP 1 & 2 (ALL GIRLS)

Now it's no wonder that her name means 'beauty' Her looks have got no parallel **GROUP 3 & 4 (ALL BOYS)** But behind that fair façade I'm afraid she's rather odd **GROUP 4** Very different from the rest of us **GROUP 4 & 2** She's nothing like the rest of us **GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE)** Yes, different from the rest of us is Belle

(We hear a loud gunshot. Lefou rushes onstage, holding a gunnysack open toward the sky... ready to catch the fallen prey.)

LEFOU | got it. | got it. | got...

(duck drop)

Wow.

(A large duck drops onstage, missing the bag entirely. He quickly picks it up, drops it into the bag as Gaston enters. He carries a large smoking gun. Gaston is a very handsome, rude, narcissistic, egomaniacal hunter who is willing to go to any lengths to get what he wants. Lefou is his dim-witted hanger-on.)

LEFOU

You didn't miss a shot, Gaston. You're the greatest hunter in the whole world!

GASTON I know LEFOU No beast alive stands a chance against you! And no girl for that matter. **GASTON** It's true, Lefou. And I've got my sights set on that one. **LEFOU** The inventor's daughter? **GASTON** She's the one. The lucky girl I'm going to marry. **LEFOU** But, she's... **GASTON** That makes her the best.

(He grabs Lefou in an beefy hand and pulls him up nose-to-nose.)

And don't I deserve the best? **LEFOU** Well, of course you do!

(Gaston drops Lefou and sings.)

GASTON

Right from the moment when I met her, saw her I said she's gorgeous and I fell Here in town there's only she Who is beautiful as me So I'm making plans to woo and marry Belle

(He strides across the stage toward Belle, crossing in front of the 6 twittering Silly Girls. They swoon as he passes)

SILLY GIRLS

Look there he goes! Isn't he dreamy? Monsieur Gaston! Oh, he's so cute! Be still my heart! I'm hardly breathing! He's such a tall, dark, strong and handsome brute!

(The stage comes alive as Villagers crowd through the marketplace.)

GROUP 2 Bonjour GASTON Pardon BELLE Good day GROUP 1 Mais oui! GROUP 2 You call this bacon? GROUP 1 What lovely grapes!

BAKER Some cheese... GROUP 1

... Ten Yards **GROUP 4** ... One pound GASTON 'Scuse Me! **GROUP 3** I'll get the knife. GASTON Please let me through! **GROUP 2** This bread... **GROUP 1** Those fish... **GROUP 2** ... It's stale! **GROUP 1** ... They smell!

GROUP 3 & 4 (All boys)

Madame's Mistaken Good Morning!

Good Morning!

Oh

GROUP 1 & 2 (All girls) Well, Maybe so! Good Morning!

Oh

Good Morning!

GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE)

Look there she goes... A girl who's strange but special A most peculiar mademoiselle **GROUP 1 & 2 (All girls)** It's a pity and a sin **GROUP 3 & 4 (All boys)** She doesn't quite fit in **GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE)** 'Cause she really is a funny girl A beauty but a funny girl She really is a funny girl That Belle!

(Feeling their eyes on her, Belle whirls around and the townsfolk quickly go back to their activities. The Villagers exit. Belle heads for home. Gaston and Lefou are close behind Belle. Gaston runs around in front of her ... striking a nonchalant pose.)

BELLE

There must be More than this Provincial Life **GASTON** Just watch, I'm going to make Belle my wife!

Act One: Scene Síx

<u>"Gaston"</u>

LEFOU

Gosh it disturbs me to see you, Gaston Looking so down in the dumps Every guy here'd love to be you, Gaston, Even when taking your lumps There's no man in town as admired as you -You're everyone's fa-vour-ite guy -Everyone's awed and inspired by you And it's not very hard to see why No-one's slick as Gaston No-one's quick as Gaston No-one's neck's as incredibly thick as Gaston! For there's no man in town half as manly Perfect! A pure paragon! You can ask any Tom, Dick or Stanley And they'll tell you whose team They'd prefer to be on!

(Lefou is joined by Gaston's cronies. The group begins to sing and sway in an effort to cheer up their idol, Gaston. And, gradually, it starts to work.)

CRONIES

No one's been like Gaston, A Kingpin like Gaston LEFOU No-one's got a swell cleft in his chin like Gaston! GASTON As a specimen, yes I'm intimidating! ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 My, what a guy, that Gaston! Give five hurrahs! Give twelve hip-hips! LEFOU Gaston is the best and the rest is all drips! ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 No one fights like Gaston! Douses lights like Gaston! LEFOU In a wrestling match, nobody bites like Gaston SILLY GIRLS For there's no-one as burley and brawny GASTON As you see, I've got biceps to spare

LEFOU

Not a bit of him's scraggly or scrawny **GASTON** That's right! And every last inch of me's covered with hair! **CRONIES** No one hits like Gaston ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 Matches wits like Gaston LEFOU In a spitting match nobody spits like Gaston GASTON I'm especially good at expectorating! Ptooey! ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 Ten points for Gaston! GASTON When I was a lad I ate four dozen eggs Every morning to help me get large And now that I'm grown, I eat five dozen eggs So I'm roughly the size of a barge ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4

(Gaston poses)

OOOOH, AAAAH, WOW!

ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4

My what a guy that Gaston

(Dance Break)

ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4

No one shoots like Gaston Makes those beauts like Gaston **LEFOU** Then goes tromping around Wearing boots like Gaston **GASTON** I use antlers in all of my decorating! **ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4** My what a guy!

LEFOU

What a guy!

GROUP 1, 2, 3 & 4 (EVERYONE) GASTON!

GASTON

Drinks on Lefou!

(Maurice enters, panicked)

MAURICE

Help! Help! Someone help me!

Act One: Scene Seven "Be Our Guest"

Be our guest! Be our guest!

LUMIERE

(into song)

Ma chere, Mademoiselle it is with deepest pride and greatest pleasure that we welcome you tonight. And now we invite you to relax, let us pull up a chair, as the Dining Room proudly presents... your dinner!

(The number proceeds in the style of an elaborate Cabaret show. Lumiere serves as Master of Ceremonies)

Put our service to the test Tie a napkin 'round your neck, Cherie And we'll provide the rest Soup du jour Hot hors d'oeuvre! Why, we only live to serve Try the grey stuff-CHIP It's delicious! LUMIERE Don't believe me? Ask the dishes! They can sing, they can dance! After all miss, this is France! And a dinner here is never second best Go on, unfold your menu Take a glance, and then you'll Be our guest Oui, our guest! Be our guest! CHIP & ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 Beef ragout! Cheese soufflé! Pie and pudding en flambé! LUMIERE We'll prepare and serve with flair A culinary cabaret! You're alone and you're scared But the banquet's all prepared! No one's gloomy or complaining While the flatware's entertaining CHIP & ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 We tell jokes, LUMIERE I do tricks With my fellow candlesticks

We'll make you shout encore And send us out for more So be our guest LUMIERE Be our guest **EVERYONE** Be our guest CHIP & ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 Ahhhhhhhhhhh Ahhhhhhhhhhhh Ahhhhhhhhhhh **MRS POTTS** It's a guest! It's a guest! Sakes alive, well I'll be blessed! Wine's been poured and thank the lord I've had the napkins freshly pressed ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2 & 3 With dessert, she'll want tea While the cups do their soft-shoeing I'll be bubbling! I'll be brewing! I'll get warm, piping hot Badabop ba, Heaven's sakes! Is that a spot Badabop ba, Badabop ba Clean it up! We want the company impressed! Bop bop ba ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 + CHIP, MRS POTTS, COGSWORTH & BABBETTE We've got a lot to do **MRS POTTS** Is it one lump or two For you, our guest

ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 + CHIP

She's our guest!

MRS POTTS She's our guest ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 + CHIP She's our guest! Be our guest! Be our guest! Be our guest! LUMIERE Life is so unnerving For a servant who's not serving He's not whole without a soul to wait upon Ah, those good old days when we were useful Suddenly, those good old days are gone Ten years we've been rusting Needing so much more than dusting Needing exercise – a chance to use our skills Most days we just lay around the castle Flabby, fat and lazy You walked in and whoops-a-daisy

Babette! BABETTE Come to me, my little spark LUMIERE Ah-choo! Oui BABETTE No! COGSWORTH Lumiere! This time you've gone too far. This is shameless! Shameless! EVERYONE Hey! LUMIERE

(As napkins enter)

Allo! **NAPKINS (CAN CAN GIRLS)** Hi! **LUMIERE** And now, for your continued dining pleasure – Napkins...s'il vous plait! **NAPKINS (CAN CAN GIRLS)** Ooh la la!

(all together)

Un, deux, trois, quatre, çinq, six, sept, wheee!

ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 + CHIP, WARDROBE, MRS POTTS, COGSWORTH, LUMIERE, BABETTE Be our guest! Be our guest! Our command is your request It's been years since we've had anybody here And we're obsessed With your meal, with your ease Yes, indeed, we aim to please While the candlelight's still glowing Let us help you, we'll keep going Course by course One by one 'Til you shout, "ENOUGH, I'M DONE!" ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1&2 BABETTE **ENSEMBLE GROUPS 3&4** + CHIP, COGSWORTH, WARDROBE, MRS POTTS & LUMIERE Then we'll sing you off to sleep as Ha ha ha ha ha You digest На

ENSEMBLE GROUPS 1, 2, 3 & 4 + CHIP, WARDROBE, MRS POTTS, COGSWORTH, LUMIERE, BABETTE

Tonight you'll prop your feet up! But for now, let's eat up! Be our guest! Be our guest! Be our guest! Please be our guest!

BELLE

Oh, Lumiere, thank you for dinner. It was delicious **COGSWORTH** Good show, everyone! Good show! Well done! Well done! Oh my goodness, look at the time. Off to bed!
